AUDIT REPORTS OF LIQUIDATED BANKS, 1923-1940.

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These records consist of audit reports submitted to the Commissioner of Banks regarding banks which had been liquidated, or whose condition warranted such action. The original statutory provisions for liquidation of banks were set forth in the Public Laws of North Carolina, 1921, Chapter 4, section 17. Although subsequent sessions of the General Assembly expanded and amended liquidation procedures, the audit reports were basically unaffected by this legislation. [See G. S. 53-20].
