Biographical/Historical note

The North Carolina General Assembly is the state of North Carolina's state legislature. This elected body makes the laws of North Carolina, also known as the General Statutes. It is a bicameral legislature consisting of the North Carolina House of Representatives (formerly the North Carolina House of Commons) and the North Carolina Senate. The House has 120 members; the Senate has 50. Legislators in both chambers serve two-year terms. The North Carolina General Assembly meets in the state capital of Raleigh (except for special occasions, when legislators might decide to hold a ceremonial session in some other city).

Collection Overview

This collection consists of composite photographs of the North Carolina General Assembly. Also included are: one original photograph depicting a composite of members of the NC Constitutional Convention of 1875; a color portrait of Lt. Gov. James C. Gardner, President of the NC Senate 1989-1992; a sepia portrait of House Speaker Josephus L. Mavretic, 1989-90; four color portraits of Luther H. Hodges, former NC Governor; and a photograph of Henson Barnes, President Pro Tempore of the NC Senate 1989.
