"Register of Letters Outwards Began 5th January, 1768".

- 1Ab 1768 May. Custom House, Boston. General letter no. 1 from Board of Customs to "the Collectors & Comptrollers of all his Majesty's ports in North America". To send to American Board of Customs at Boston, rather than to Board in London, duplicates of all ships' registers taken in their office.
- 2 1768 Aug 26. Custom House, Castle William [Boston]. General letter no. 2 from same to [same]. Encloses new forms for keeping accounts.
- 3b-4 1769 March 14. Custom House, Boston. General letter no. 3 from same to [same]. Detailed directions on keeping accounts of goods imported from Great Britain and Ireland according to the new forms.
- 11 1769 July 28. Custom House [Boston]. Same to Collector at Beaufort, North Carolina, wanting list of shipping there from 8 Sept 1767 to 10 Oct 1767: is third time this request has been made.
- 12b-13 1769 Oct 18. Custom House, Boston. Same to Collector and Comptroller at Currituck, concerning confused state of shipping returns.
- 14b 1769 Nov 3. Custom House, Boston. General letter no. 4. from same to [collectors and comptrollers at ports in North America]. Procedure for sending in their returns.
- 15b Postscript [presumably to above] for Roanoke, Beaufort, Bath Town.
- 15b 1769 Dec 8. [Custom House, Boston]. Brief note to collector at Brunswick concerning procedure for sending in accounts of vessels registered there.
- 17b 1770 Feb 8. Custom House, Boston. General letter no. 5 from same to customs officials at various ports, not incl. those in North Carolina.
- 22 1771 Feb 23. [Custom House, Boston]. Same to customs officials at Currituck, incl. those in North Carolina. To send forthwith copies of books for last two quarters, and to be "more regular" in transmitting same.
- 25 1771 May 6. [Custom House, Boston]. Same to collector and comptroller of customs at Roanoke. To send copies of books for quarter ending 10 Oct 1770.
- 26b-27 1771 June. [Custom House, Boston]. Same to same. To send exact account of goods imported from Great Britain, and of ships registered at Roanoke.
- 32-32b 1774 Oct 12. [Custom House, Boston]. General letter from inspector of imports and exports, and register of shipping in America to [customs officials in North America, with exceptions noted on f.32b]. Revised procedure for keeping of records of shipping and registrations.
- 32b [Apparently postscript to above]. Same [?] to customs officials at Currituck, ordering them to be more careful with accounts.
- 34b-35 1775 March 2. Custom House, Boston. James Murray, Inspector of Imports, to, among others, collector and comptroller of Currituck, for accounts since 5 Apr 1773; Roanoke, for same since 10 Oct 1773; Beaufort, for same since 5 July 1773.
