1. 1781 Jan 1 - Dec 31. Treasury account of 10s. fee received in June, 1783, for signing a transcript of the public accounts of Major Richard England, deputy quartermaster general in the district of North and South Carolina during 1781. 77,897.1-2
2. 1782 Feb 19. Treasury account of 10s. fee received in June, 1785, for signing a transcript of the public accounts of Christopher Potter for victualling 10,000 men in North and South Carolina, Georgia, and East Florida, dated 19 Feb. 1782. 77,898.1-2
3. 1780 May - Dec 1782. Treasury account of a fee of £1.6.6 received in July, 1789 for signing the public account for 1780-1782 of Charles Stedman and Benjamin Booth Boote, Commissaries of Captures in North and South Carolina and Virginia. 77,899.1-2
4. 1781 Feb 6. Treasury account of a Chancellor's fee of 10s. received on 19 Jan 1792 for passing the account of Richard V. Sadlier for victualling 3,000 men in Carolina per contract 6 Feb 1781. 77,900.1-2
