INDEX TO MILITARY UNITS

The following index to military units is divided into four (4) sections: (1) North Carolina numbered regiments and battalions (Confederate); (II) North Carolina named units; (III) out-of-state units (Confederate); and (IV) Federal units.

In Section 1, North Carolina numbered regiments and battalions have been arranged numerically. Under each number, battalions follow regiments.

In Section II, named units are arranged alphabetically by unit name or by surname of commanding officer, as appropriate.

Cross-references have been made between Sections I and II, where known.

In Section III, out-of-state units are arranged by state followed by C.S.A. units.

In Section IV, Federal units have been arranged numerically.

In all sections, references to military units show location of materials in this collection by box number, followed by folder name or number in parentheses.

Although an attempt has been made to show organizational changes and to make appropriate cross-references, the complexity of these changes has made a thorough resume impractical. Accordingly, the researcher is referred to Louis H. Manarin (comp.), *A Guide to Military Organizations and Installations, North Carolina, 1861-1865* (Raleigh: The North Carolina Confederate Centennial Commission, 1961), which includes a detailed account of these organizational changes. A copy of this guide is available in the Archives.
