

ACTIVITY: Finding Towns

During the early years of statehood, governors lived in their own houses and the General Assembly moved from place to place, meeting in private residences and in courthouses when available. The 3rd section of the 1776 constitution provided for two representatives from each county in the House of Commons. Six counties with the largest towns could send an additional representative to the Assembly.

Should the General Assembly have selected one of those 6 towns for the capital? If so, which one should they have chosen and why? If not, what would be the best location to establish a new town and why?*

As the state's population in the western part of the state grew, a 1788 State Convention voted to fix the capital within ten miles of a popular tavern at a crossroads in Wake County (formed in 1771). A committee later purchased 1,000 acres adjacent to the Wake County courthouse (rather than the tavern), and established Raleigh as the capital city.

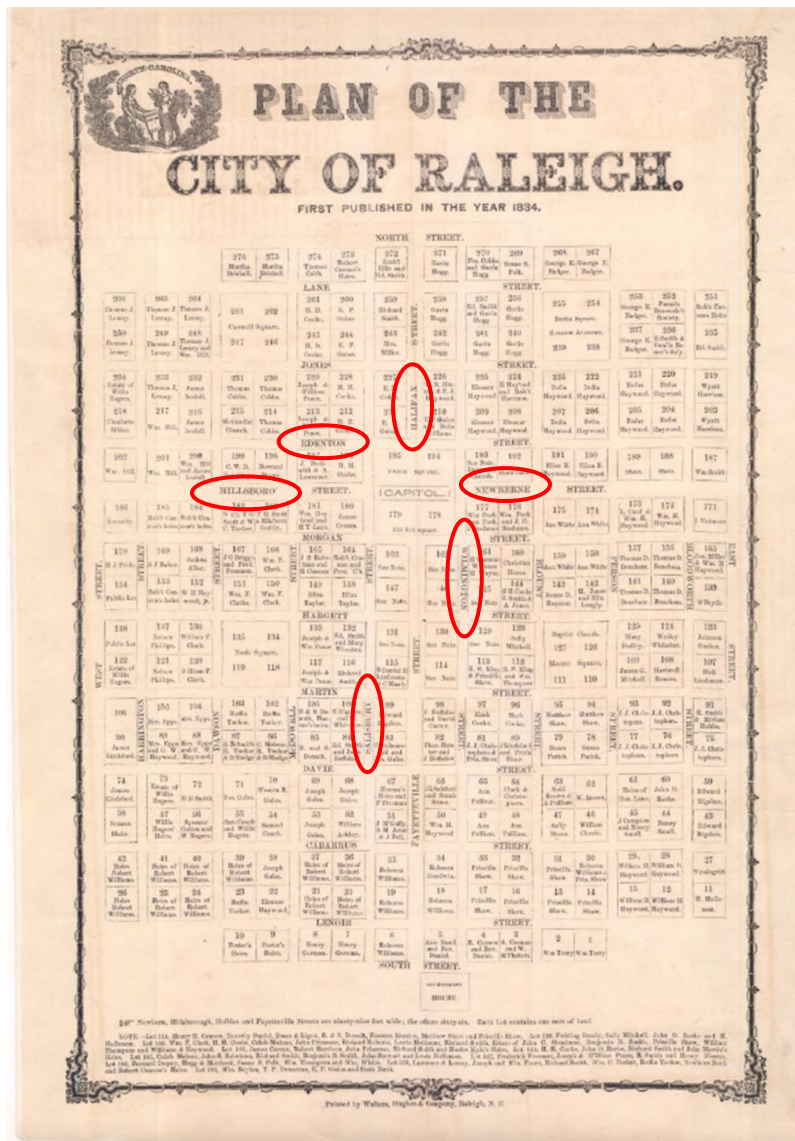

ACTIVITY: Finding Towns

With a growing proportion of citizens living in the Piedmont and more settlers moving westward to the mountains, state leaders were trying to find a central location. Wake County had been created out of Johnston in 1771 (Note that the map published in 1779 represents an earlier version.) An east-west road connected New Bern to western settlements, including Salem, and a north-south road served as a link between Petersburg, Virginia, and Charleston, South Carolina. This crossroads was the site of a popular tavern—Isaac Hunter's. The N.C. General Assembly met at the nearby Wake County courthouse in 1781, less than a mile away from the future location of the State Capitol. Also, the University of North Carolina had been chartered in Chapel Hill, a day's ride away, in 1792.
