burthen	burden
constrained	limited by force
demeaned	put down in terms of status or reputation
enjoined	to force
fidelity	loyalty, faithfulness
incumbent	obligatory
intimating	hinting
latter	the last item or most recent item mentioned
lenity	leniency; not harsh or strict
levy	to assign or collect by legal authority
manifests	lists of contents, such as a ship's cargo; v. to take shape
Moravians	a Christian Protestant group known for being conservative and non-violent
piety	devoutness or adherence to a religious faith
Quakers	a Christian Protestant group known for rejecting war and social reform
redress	to make right; to compensate
renunciation	a denial
scruple	a choice made by ethical principle or belief
sojourn	a temporary stay away from home
transgressed	broken a law or rule
