Extraditions and Requisitions, fugitive warrants, waiver of extraditions, detainers, executive agreements, general correspondence, waivers and warrants, bills of indictment, certifications, and true copies of records of fugitive criminals are included in the papers.

Black's Law Dictionary defines extradition as "the surrender by one state to another of an individual accused or convicted of an offense outside its own territory and within the territorial jurisdiction of the other, which, being competent to try and punish him, demands the surrender." A requisition is "the formal demand . . . by the governor of one of the United States upon the governor of a sister state, of the surrender of a fugitive criminal." If a fugitive waives extradition, he agrees voluntarily to return for trial to the state in which the crime was committed.

The primary legal duties are derived from the constitutional powers of the governor and include the processing of all clemency requests (commutations and pardons), preparation of clemency orders, and the review of extradition requests. The Governor's Legal Counsel Office also issues reward proclamations and deals with citizens' and inmates' calls and correspondence.
