1    **Ricky A. Blue Papers.**

Contains military photo identification card, 1990, for PO3/E4 Ricky A. Blue of Maxton (Robeson County), who served in the U.S. Navy aboard the battleship, USS *Iowa*.

**Robert W. Holmes Papers.**

Contains typescript reminiscences of Lt. Robert W. Holmes of Virginia concerning his service as a tank platoon leader in the 24th Infantry Division.

**Sterling Nicholson Papers.**

Training materials reflecting the service of Sgt. Sterling Nicholson of Jamestown (Guilford County) in the Army National Guard during the Gulf War, including field manual: *Battle Focused Training*, 1990; booklet: *Desert Shield Aircraft Recognition*, 1990; eleven posters depicting silhouettes of Allied and Soviet airplanes, helicopters, tanks, and armored vehicles; reference cards for infantry leaders and fire observation; information wheels concerning Soviet and Warsaw Pact artillery, communications equipment, and surface-to-air missiles; and two packs of study cards: survival cards for Southeast Asia, 1968, and Soviet word recognition, 1985.

**Frederick E. Stoehr Papers.**

Papers reflecting the service of Frederick E. Stoehr of Carolina Shores, including an Iraqi soldier's handbook taken from a captured tank; ninety-six photographs of Kuwait during the Gulf War, including several of burning oil wells; three booklets: *A Diary of an Iraqi Soldier*, (1992); *A Message to Whom the Issues of this Nation May Concern* (1992); and *Construction and Distruction* [sic], concerning the Kuwait National Museum; and three newspapers: issue of the *Kuwait Times Spectrum*, April 13, 1993; issue of the *Arab Times*, April 14, 1993; and special section of the *Arab Times*, February 26, 1992.
