The general correspondence file of the governor consists of letters, reports, speeches, statements, etc. Duplicate materials have been removed; and some weeding has been done in the Governor's File among miscellaneous requests, primarily from schoolchildren, for information, brochures, etc., on North Carolina. A representative sample of such requests has been retained.

Duplicate printed materials related to North Carolina have been transferred to the State Library. Empty file folders have been retained with a notice to that effect placed in the folder. The filing system used by the Governor's Office is essentially the same as the one initiated in 1967.

Although the structure of state government was changed in 1972 under the Executive Organization Act of 1971, the 1974 files do not always reflect this new structure. Some agencies are identified by their pre-1972 titles; and their records are filed under their old designations.

All records and evidence compiled by the State Bureau of Investigation are considered restricted and confidential material available to the public only upon court order (G.S. 114-15). The 1974 Governor's Papers contain one such report on a Department of Agriculture personnel matter. This file is not to be viewed by any person without the permission of the State Bureau of Investigation. Permission cannot be granted by Governor Holshouser or the Governor's Office.
