1. N.D. (1781?) Record of a journey to join Cornwallis and accompany him throughout North Carolina. Gives dates, places stayed and events. (eg. "15 Mar. General action at Guilford Court House.") Number of miles travelled are also given. Ends with junction of troops at Petersburg, Virginia on 20th May, 1781.

1. 1758, 20 Mar. New York. Forbes to Governor Dobbs. Forbes is now in charge of frontier troops and urges Dobbs to seek dispatch of North Carolina's allotment of troops for the troops. Also mentions the Cherokees who are to join forces with Forbes in Pennsylvania and Virginia in the spring and will march through North Carolina and asks Dobbs to assist them.
